The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.169 dated 19.08.2017, registered under Sections 364, 323, 341, 342, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala.

It has been submitted that it is a case of quarrel between the students.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 22.11.2018 is made

absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.
