The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 68 dated 16.07.2017 under Sections 302, 364, 325, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.07.2018. The investigation is complete but the examination of PWs has not yet commenced. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and even in this case the allegation against him is that he caused a dang blow to one Surinder Singh but there is no role attributed in the death of Ranjit Singh. Thus, the petitioner may be released on regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that all the accused persons had acted in collusion with each other and, thus, role of a particular accused can not be segregated. So far as the factual submissions are concerned, he does not deny the same.

Thus, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
