Prayer in this revision petition is for setting aside the judgment dated 12.12.2014, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, vide which the appeal filed by respondent No. 2 Gora Singh was allowed and the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 03.09.2014, passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot convicting respondent No. 2, as mentioned below, was set aside:

Section 452 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for 03 years and to pay a fine of ₹1000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo simple imprisonment for 02 months.
Section 382 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for 03 years and to pay a fine of ₹1000/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo simple imprisonment for 02 months.
Section 506 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for 01 year and to pay a fine of ₹500/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo simple imprisonment for 01 month.
Section 427 IPC	To undergo rigorous imprisonment for 01 year and to pay a fine of ₹500/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo simple imprisonment for 01 month.

During the pendency of this revision petition, the parties have compromised the matter and the parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording their statements. In the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, the compromise has been reduced in writing and a compromise/settlement dated 18.04.2018 has been effected. As per the said compromise/settlement, the present revision petition is to be disposed of as per the terms and conditions contained in para No. 6 of the said compromise/settlement.

Accordingly, this revision petition is disposed of.

The parties shall remain bound by the compromise/settlement dated 18.04.2018, effected before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.
