Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.156 dated 12.10.2018 under Sections 61 and 78 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 (1 of 1914) registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits on 26.11.2018, the following order was passed:-

***“..... Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, on seeing the car when the police party signalled to stop, the petitioner fled away from the spot leaving the car and 48 bottles of country made liquor meant for sale in Haryana were recovered. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is not the owner of the car and the recovery has already been effected. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.
Notice of motion for 03.12.2018*”**

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gamdoor Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, order dated 26.11.2018 is made absolute.
