The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to investigate the matter fairly in case FIR No.86 dated 11.10.2018, under Sections 376-D, 377, 323, 306 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Women, Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that the representations dated 15.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) and dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representations of the petitioner within a period of six weeks on receipt

of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representations dated 15.10.2018 (Annexure P-3) and dated 30.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
