The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 59 dated 08.02.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 405, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2018 and the investigation in the matter has already been completed. It is further contended that charges have already been framed on 01.10.2018 and there are total 10 prosecution witnesses, but none has been examined till date. It is also contended that the civil suit is also pending between the parties.

Learned State counsel has opposed prayer of bail on the ground that the petitioner is the beneficiary and hence he prays for dismissal of the present petition.

Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper book.

Undisputedly, the civil suit is pending between the parties and the matter is within the family itself. The petitioner is in custody since 27.06.2018. The charges have already been framed by learned trial Court and the case is fixed for 11.12.2018 for prosecution witnesses. The trial is likely to take a long time to be concluded and as such no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars any more.

Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioner-Mahesh Kumar be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
