The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 03.06.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 & 326 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Heard.

Petitioners were arrested on 16.08.2018 and they are in custody since then. In this case, challan has been presented and the charges have been framed.

On instructions from ASI Amandeep Kaur, learned State counsel stated that no other case is registered against the petitioners.

Considering the custody period undergone by the petitioners

and the fact that the petitioners are not involved in any other case and also the fact that trial will take its own time, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one surety of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioners shall surrender their passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioners shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioners shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of their absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
