LISA GILL, J.

This appeal has been filed by the claimant challenging award dated 07.03.2005 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal, whereby claim petition filed under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicle Act was dismissed.

Present is an appeal which was burnt in the fire incident which took place on the High Court premises in the year 2011. Following order was passed on 18.09.2018: -

“This matter has been put up by the Registry as learned counsel for the appellant has failed to supply correct address of respondent No. 1 despite various requests. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the appellant.

Necessary steps for furnishing the correct address of respondent No. 1 be taken by learned counsel for the appellant within three weeks. Fresh notice be thereafter issued to respondent No. 1 for 17.12.2018.

Learned counsel for the appellant be notified of the date fixed.

Legible copy of award/paper book and available record be also supplied by learned counsel for the appellant.”

Today there is no representation on behalf of the appellant, despite learned counsel for the appellant being notified of the date fixed, neither any steps have been taken in terms of order dated 18.09.2018. It appears that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

Dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
