Petitioners have approached this Court by filing the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.10 dated 08.01.2014 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 120-B IPC (Section 34 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural with all consequential proceedings, on the basis of compromise dated 26.02.2014 (Annexure P-2).

On instructions from ASI Ramji Dass, learned State counsel states that in this case, cancellation report has already been prepared but yet to be presented before the trial Court.

On the directions of this Court, report of the Lower Court was called for. Learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Jagraon, has recorded the statement of the complainant-injured as well as accused and has reported that the parties have effected compromise which is without any coercion or

pressure from any corner and the same is found to be genuine.

As the parties have compromised the matter and the police has already preparing the cancellation report, therefore, continuation of further proceedings in the FIR will be useless exercise. As such, FIR No.10 dated 08.01.2014 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 120-B IPC (Section 34 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural with all consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioners.

Accordingly, petition is allowed.
