The grievance of the petitioner is that a complaint has been filed by him against respondent No.7 regarding cheating him on the pretext of sending his son to Dubai, but the police is not carrying out proper investigation. Instead, the petitioner is being threatened by respondent No.7 with aid of respondent Nos.5 and 6 and is being forced to settle the matter with respondent No.7. A detailed representation dated 23.10.2017 (Annexure P1) was submitted, but the same has not yielded any result.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Bains, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.5 to 7, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P1) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
