Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.6 and 7 who have installed CCTV cameras facing towards the main gate of the petitioner's house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondents No.6 and 7 have no right to install CCTV cameras facing the house of the petitioner. He further states in this respect, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 10.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to consider and decide the representation of the petitioner dated 10.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioner.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra to take note of the contents of petitioner's representation dated 10.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) and to act in accordance with law.
