The petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Deputy Ranger and place the petitioner above Shri Babu Singh in the seniority list of Deputy Rangers and grant him consequential benefits arising out of the said promotion along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date when the said benefits became due till the date of actual payment.

With the understanding that the issue raised in the petition has substantially been settled in favour of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawan.

As it is not clear at this stage that whether any relief claimed by the petitioner remains unsettled, the petitioner is granted liberty to revive the present petition or to file a fresh one on the same cause of action within three months from today.
