Above-referred petitions are being disposed of by this common order as they are connected.

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 62 dated 06.04.2015, registered under Sections 307, 354-D, 341, 323, 34 IPC and Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act (Sections 336 IPC and Section 30/54/59 of Arms Act added later on), Police Station City Sunam , District Sangrur and all other consequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of written compromise arrived at between the parties.

Reports have been called from the trial Court after statements of the parties regarding the compromise were recorded. The trial Court has reported that the compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion. Trial Court has also sent statements of parties along with the report.

Counsel for the petitioners stated that Sections 307 & 354 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act were deleted and Section 336 IPC and Section 30/54/59 of Arms Act were added later on. Counsel for the petitioner states that no-one was injured in this incident.

Learned State counsel informs that challan was not presented.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements made by the parties and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. 2007(3) RCR(CrL.) 1052,** approved by Hon'ble the Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. 2012(10) SCC 303,** both the petitions are allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all the consequent proceedings conducted therein are quashed qua the petitioners.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise.
