It is alleged that petitioner alongwith his three friends was present outside Lotus Garden, Sector 44, Chandigarh. All four boys, while keeping liquor glasses on the bonnet of car make Chevrolet Cruz, were drinking liquor, making noise and dancing. When police tried to persuade them, they abused police officials and scuffled with them, with the result that dress of complainant police official HC Karam Chand was torn. One of the boys Gagandeep Singh was apprehended, whereas three remaining absconded.

Keeping in view the nature of offence, I am of view that it is not a case of undue hardship. Such type of incidents in the city are not tolerable. Petition is thus dismissed.
