Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.177, dated 17.08.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 148,149,224,225,332,353,427,436,452,506 of IPC registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegation against the petitioner No.1 and 3 is that they had protested against the police for bringing one Sumit to the Police Post and further that only allegation against the other petitioners is that when co-accused, namely, Mohinder had intimidated them, then they also reached the Police Post. However, there is no separate and specific allegations against the present petitioners.

Learned counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Younus Ali Submits that the petitioners are involved in obstructing the Police in performing its duties. However, it is not disputed that there is no separate and specific allegations qua any incident against the present petitioners.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
