The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881, because the bail granted by the trial Court was cancelled on 21.10.2017 as she was declared a proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of various personal difficulties, the petitioner was not in a position to appear before the trial Court and applications for exemption were filed, but the same were rejected.

Every citizen is governed by the law of this country howsoever high and mighty he/she may be. All difficulties and problems have to be balanced with the duty to comply with the process of the Court, and to submit to the majesty of law. No citizen can be permitted to take of the law in his/her own hands and to try and dictate terms to the Courts.

Thus, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court/Magistrate on 12.02.2018 at 10.00 a.m with liberty to move an application for grant of regular bail, explaining all the circumstances which kept her away from Court proceedings. The trial Court/Magistrate shall decide such bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.
