Learned State counsel states that the petitioners have joined the investigation. This Court has been further informed that the complainant has put some idol under the tree, which can obstruct the passage. Earlier also, idol was removed. Now, the same has been put up and yesterday another FIR has been registered against the complainant and others.

Considering the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and that the dispute is regarding placing of idol under the tree to make it place of workshop, the interim anticipatory bail granted to the petitioners is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
