The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.39 dated 20.05.2018, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The aforesaid FIR was registered against the petitioner on the allegation that they have tress-passed in to the house of the complainant and caused him injuries.

However, the injuries are simple and on non-vital parts. Recoveries of dandas have been effected. Nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 27.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
