Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 and 3A to take necessary legal action on the representations moved by the petitioner dated 14.02.2017 (Annexures P-20 and P-21). Prayer has also been made for constitution of a Special Investigation Team to conduct investigation in FIRs (Annexures P-16 to P-19) lodged against the petitioner by respondents No.10 to 13 in order to compel the petitioner to withdraw his complaint dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-1).

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner. Even on the earlier date i.e. 10.09.2018, no one was present on his behalf. Therefore, this Court, while adjourning the case for today, had directed the Registry to inform the petitioner as well as his counsel.

The Registry has reported that information has been given to the counsel for the petitioner wherein it has been reported that the petitioner has

taken back his brief/case from the counsel. It has been further reported that

information letter was issued to the petitioner, but the same was not received back served or otherwise.

It has been informed by learned State counsel that the petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender in four cases and nine FIRs have been registered against him.

In view of above, this Court has no other option except to dismiss the present petition for non-prosecution.
