By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has made multiple prayers, but learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner confines her prayer to the extent of protection of her life and liberty only. He further states that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.3 Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to consider the representation dated 05.11.2018 (Annexure P-3) made by the petitioner regarding protection of her life and liberty only at the hands of private respondent No.5.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, but considering the fact that the petitioner has restricted her prayer qua the protection of her life and liberty only, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Kapurthala to look into the matter qua the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner only and to act in accordance with law.
