Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4 and further to complete the investigation in FIR No.08 dated 29.06.2017, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ferozepur, under Sections 7 and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the relief in respect of protecting life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4 at this stage. However, he submits that investigation in the aforesaid FIR is still pending and the official respondents may be directed to expedite the completion of investigation in the aforesaid FIR.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid extent.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel.

Heard.

Respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ferozepur is directed to expedite the completion of investigation in the aforesaid FIR and to present the final report at the earliest.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Vigilance Bureau, Ferozepur, who will look into the matter personally.

With aforesaid directions, this petition stands disposed of.
