The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the respondents not to harass the petitioner and his family unnecessarily and further for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to protect

the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family at the hands of respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR No.188 dated 08.11.2018 under Sections 302, 307, 148 and 149 IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 was registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) against Davinder Saini, who is a son of the petitioner and other accused. After the registration of said FIR, the police is visiting the house of the petitioner repeatedly despite the fact that Davinder Saini is no more residing with the petitioner and he has been disinherited by the petitioner from his property.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contended that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 09.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the Director General of Police, Punjab and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur is directed to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2-State.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Senior

Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the contents of representation dated 09.11.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
