Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and their specimen signatures have been taken regarding the two receipts issued by them for Rs. 20.00 lacs or Rs. 26.00 lacs.

On the other hand, learned Sr. counsel for the petitioners admits the signatures on the aforesaid two receipts.

A perusal of the FIR shows that it is a case of lending money which was not returned. Petitioners issued the aforesaid receipts which according to them were issued as guarantor. Basically, it appears to be a civil dispute. Nothing is to be recovered from the present petitioners.

In view of the matter, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 28.11.2018 is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
