Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.185 dated 01.12.2017 registered under Sections 366, 328, 109, 506/34 IPC and Sections 4, 12 & 17 of POCSO Act at Police Station Women, Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegations of rape were against Anil and the allegations were that Sheela, mother of the petitioner, has introduced the boys to the victim. Counsel states that the petitioner was not named in the first statement made under Section 164 Cr.P.C. but he was named in the second statement and the allegations are that a video was made of the incident but no video was recovered.

Learned State counsel states that the statements of the complainant and the prosecutrix have been recorded.

Petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2018.

The trial would take time. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
