JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 122 dated 13.9.2018, under Sections 366, 366-A, 363, 506, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated. Co-accused of the petitioner has been enlarged on bail by this Court. It is also argued that in all probability the prosecutrix has gone abroad, as she recently had got a passport issued, while contending that the petitioner was on active duty on the date of occurrence. It is also argued that the trial is likely to take some time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular

bail.

Per contra, learned counsel for the respondent—State has contested the bail application while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature and as such he does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that co-accused has been granted bail and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
