The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of
Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case
FIR No.106 dated 14.11.2018 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 307, 341, 506, 336 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27 of
Arms Act, at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Heard.

FIR was registered on the statement of Daljit Singh son of

Gitan Singh with regard to firing shots towards the vehicle. However, none

has received bodily injury. Today, complainant along with his counsel has appeared and submit that now a compromise has been effected between the parties.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the investigating officer and join the investigation within seven days and he be granted anticipatory bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/SHO concerned and subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
