The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 472 dated 20.05.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 302, 323, 324 IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar, Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 21.05.2017. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as out of 20 PWs only 7 PWs have been examined till date. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner. Reliance is placed upon order dated 22.11.2018 passed in CRM-M-41148-2018 to submit that similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail and, therefore, the petitioner also deserves the same concession.

The aforesaid factual submissions are not disputed by learned State counsel.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
