Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to transfer the investigation regarding the death of son of the petitioner to the Central Bureau of Investigation or some independent agency.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3 –Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is directed to look into the matter.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3–Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to treat the instant petition as representation. Copy of the same be forwarded to respondent No.3. In the alternative, the petitioner is directed to represent respondent No.3, raising all the grouses, which, he has raised

in the instant petition, within two weeks. Thereafter, respondent No.3 would look into the matter and make strenuous efforts to redress the grievances of the petitioner, within next two months.
