The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 217 dated 25.08.2018, registered under Section 506 IPC and Section 8 of the POCSO Act, Police Station Sadar Narwana, District Jind.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he caught hold of the hand of the prosecutrix in the street and ran away after extending threat.

Counsel for the petitioner urges that no allegation of threat was made in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and the only allegation is that he caught hold of the hand of the prosecutrix. Counsel for the petitioner urges that challan has been presented, charge has been framed and the petitioner is in custody since 26.08.2018 and the trial will take time.

The State counsel says that the petitioner was harassing the prosecutrix for the last one month.

Challan has been presented and charge has been framed. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner would not contact the prosecutrix or her family members during trial. The petitioner would also give an undertaking while furnishing bonds that he would not reside or visit the colony in which the prosecutrix resides.
