It is alleged against the petitioner that along with his co-accused-Mandeep Singh was bringing 240 quarters of country made liquor bottles from Rajsthan for selling in Punjab. When confronted by the police, co-accused-Mandeep Singh was arrested but the petitioner ran away from the spot.

I am of the view that it is a case of smuggling of liquor from one State to another State and custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required to enquire about the previous activities of the petitioner regarding smuggling of liquor.

No ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.
