Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the
petition qua petitioner No.1.

Dismissed as withdrawn qua petitioner No.1 only.

Present petition is filed praying for quashing FIR No.33
dated 28.2.2016, under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 IPC registered at
Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise
entered into between the parties.

Heard.

Both the parties were directed by this Court vide order dated 22.8.2017 to appear before the learned trial Court and get their statements recorded and in pursuance thereof, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Rupnagar recorded the statements of both the parties and submitted a report 7.10.2017. A perusal of the report reveals that the compromise entered into between the parties is voluntary and without any fear, coercion, inducement or threat. Even as on today the parties are not disputing the factum of compromise arrived at between them.

Inasmuch as the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled and they have already entered into compromise, continuance of the prosecution would be an exercise in futility. Therefore, the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings resulting therefore are quashed.

Petition is allowed.
