This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 8 not to interfere in their lives, as the petitioners have performed marriage against their wishes.

On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel was directed to find out the existence of alleged threat. Learned counsel has placed on record statements of the petitioners wherein they have stated that at present they do not require any security.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners has disputed the above statement and has expressed that the same has been recorded forcibly. Even otherwise, a perusal of the pleadings in the petition are quite vague and lack all kinds of particulars. It is mentioned that private respondents No.4 to 8 may involve them in a false case, which cannot be taken as a threat to extend the protection/security.

Considering the above background, the petition is dismissed.
