Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.226 dated 09.12.2017 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Lal, pointed out that the petitioner was earlier declared proclaimed offender and this fact was not disclosed by the petitioner at the time of filing the present petitioner.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner took the plea that that he was not aware of this fact and he was not instructed on the point.

In view of the above, it is case of misrepresentation of facts by the present petitioner, as such, she does not deserve the concession of pre-arrest bail and the present petition is dismissed.
