Petitioner Ramesh Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.425 dated 17.11.2017, registered at Police Station Sector-18, Gurugram, under Sections 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 63 of the Copy Right Act, 1957 (Sections 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 added during investigation).

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

The allegation as per the FIR against the present petitioner is that he has connived with main accused Ombir Singh by misusing the Copyright of the complainant i.e. Body Buildo and the holograms and other

articles have been recovered in this case. They were selling these products through *sasta bazaar* and the present petitioner is stated to be one of the partner of *sasta bazaar* .

The petitioner has been in custody since 13.10.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
