The petitioner has preferred the instant petition for issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No.4 to 10 on account of the harassment, humiliation and threatening.

None has appeared on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 6 despite service. They are proceeded against ex parte.

As per the report of the Registry, in compliance of order dated 29.11.2018, passed by this Court, Rs.10,000/- has been deposited.

Ajay Kumar, Suresh Kumar, Bimla Devi and Vikas-respondent Nos.7 to 10 are present in person and they have no objection if the protection be granted to the petitioners with regard to their life, limb and liberty from the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 6. They also submitted that they never cause any threat to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the interim order dated 29.11.2018 is made absolute. However, petitioner No.2 Rajender Kumar is bound down by his statement made before this court on 29.11.2018.

Registry is directed to disburse Rs.1,000/- each to respondent Nos.7 to 10 against proper receipt.
