The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case anticipated to be lodged against him at the instance of Kishori Lal.

The learned State counsel has submitted that a complaint has been submitted by Kishori Lal son of Sahi Ram to the effect that he had entered into an agreement for purchase of land and had paid earnest amount of ₹15.19 lacs to the petitioner but the petitioner was not coming forward to execute the sale-deed. The learned State counsel has further informed that in order to inquire into the said allegations levelled by Kishori Lal, the petitioner had been summoned but the petitioner did not appear in response to the said summons.

In view of the aforestated position, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to ensure compliance of the directions issued by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Arnesh Kumar Versus State of Bihar and another 2014(8) SCC 273, in case any action is required to be

taken on the basis of the complaint made by Kishori Lal against the petitioner.

A copy of this order be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka so as to enable him to do the needful.
