The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.225 dated 22.08.2018, under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 IPC and under Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since September, 2018. The challan has been presented. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application while saying that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may influence the witnesses.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition

is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
