The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.18 dated 27.05.2018, registered under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Vero Ke, District Fazilka.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation; recovered has already been effected from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 30.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
