This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking pre-arrest bail in a case registered against the petitioner vide FIR No. 92 dated 28.01.2017 under sections 420 & 120-B IPC at Police Station Gurugram, district Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there has been a compromise between the parties during the pendency of this petition.
