JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.312 dated 21.09.2018, under Sections 354-A, 509, 506, 511, 376 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Kherki Daula, District Gurugram.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioners herein contends that the petitioners were taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 23.09.2018. It is submitted that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. It is also contended that investigation is complete, as the challan has been presented and charges have been framed and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time, therefore, the petitioners are entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioners, however, she does not dispute the fact that charges have been framed.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the petitioners herein have been in custody since 23.09.2018 and that investigation is complete, as the challan has been presented and charges have been framed, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioners behind bar. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
