

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by SI Bhoop Singh, submits that the alleged recovery from the petitioner is of huge quantity of 1008 capsules of medicines. Therefore, the petitioner does not deserve to be released on bail. Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that the actual quantity of prohibited substance found in the entire recovery is of 50.4 grams only. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioner.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
