Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has argued that the allegations against the petitioner are absolutely false as the FIR itself attributes the motive to co-accused, namely, Priya Saini who had been allegedly asking money from the complainant. Learned counsel has pointed out that earlier Priya Saini had got a case registered against Ajay (nephew of complainant-Dilbagh Singh) whereby FIR No.756 dated 08.07.2018 under Section 376 IPC stands registered at Police Station Sadar, District Karnal.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the fact that the co-accused-Priya is already on bail. Further, on instructions from SI Ramasre, learned State counsel submits that investigation in this case is already complete and challan has already been filed on 21.09.2018.

Without commenting anything upon merits of the case and considering the custody, the petitioner, namely, Ramesh Kumar is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court.

The petition is allowed.
