Petitioner Ravinder Singh has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.106 dated 22.10.2018, under Sections 379-B, 511 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural). He is in custody since the day of his arrest i.e. 22.10.2018.

On the basis of complaint given by Amandeep Singh, Manager of the Store, namely, Easy Day, FIR was registered on the allegations that when he was working, one person with muffled face came, who took out a toy pistol and asked him to hand over the cash. He was armed with a small sword. The complainant stood up and pushed him back, whereupon, the

person fell and on apprehension his face was uncovered. It was found that he is the security guard of the Store, namely, Ravinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR has been registered with the aid of Section 511 IPC as it is the case of attempt. He further contends that the petitioner had gone to the Store for settlement of accounts and a false case has been registered against him. The petitioner is stated to be in judicial custody and is no more required for investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh has apprised the Court that the investigation of the case is complete and the formality of submission of challan is likely to be done in a day or two.

Considered the nature of the offence as setup by the prosecution, without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petitioner, namely, Ravinder Singh is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court.

The petition is allowed.
