The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of FIR No.11 dated 10.01.2018 under Sections 323, 452 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Madhuban, Haryana.

The FIR was registered at the instance of complainant-Mamta who alleged that on 08.01.2018, the petitioner had tress-passed into the house of the complainant with an intention to kill her and had given slaps to her and also caught her from her neck and hair and pressed her neck.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the parties have reached at a compromise.

Today Mr. Sandeep Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and filed memo of appearance, which is taken on record. He has admitted the fact that parties indeed have

compromised the matter.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh has informed that the petitioner has since joined the investigation.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of allegations and bearing in mind the factum of compromise, I do not find that it to be a case of custodial interrogation. Accordingly the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued vide dated 08.02.2018 by this Court are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner would appear before Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is accepted in the above mentioned terms.
