The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 28.01.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 148/149/341/323/427 and 506 IPC, under Section 325 IPC (added vide order dated 12.07.2017) and Section 3 of the SC & ST Act, 1989, on the basis of compromise dated 23.02.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 02.03.2017, report dated 23.03.2017 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamuna Nagar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.
