The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to register a criminal case against respondents No.4 to 8 and to protect her life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 as well as at the hands of respondent No.3, who is allegedly pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer only to the extent that protection be provided to her.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of

the day, failing which no action is called.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that since the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is only limited to seeking protection, this petition is disposed of by directing the official respondents to look into the matter and in case, there is any threat perception to the petitioner, necessary protection be provided to her.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
