Parents of petitioner No. 2 have appeared in person with Mr. B.S. Aulakh, Advocate, in Court today. On their request, they were allowed to meet petitioner No. 2 in Court today. After meeting petitioner No. 2, her parents, respondents No. 4 and 5, have stated that they do not want to have any link with their daughter petitioner No. 2.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 27.11.2018. The true translated copy of marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure-P-5. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-6 (Colly.). The true typed copies of Aadhar Card and Secondary Examination Certificate, issued by Board of School Education Haryana, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and true typed copies

of Student Bank Account of Canara Bank, Main Bazar, Kalka, and
Secondary Examination Certificate, issued by Board of School Education
Haryana, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 2, have been placed on
file as Annexure-P-1 to Annexure-P-4 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application
dated 27.11.2018 before the police authorities for protecting their life and
liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents,
true typed copy of which is placed on file as Annexure-P-7.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with
a direction to Superintendent of Police, Panchkula-respondent No. 2, to
consider the application of the petitioners dated 27.11.2018 (Annexure-P-7)
and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and
if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps
be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order
shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the
parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
