Petitioners are seeking direction to learned trial court to decide the trial vide FIR No.44 dated 16.04.2015, under Sections 283, 290, 150, 160, 341, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 8-B of National Highway Act, 1954.

It has been submitted that the petitioners were declared innocent during investigation and in the inquiry conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Kartarpur but subsequently, chargesheet has been submitted on 13th June, 2018 and now trial shall take more time.

This petition is disposed of with direction to learned trial court to hear the petitioners on the point of charge, in case *prima facie* case is made out then frame the charge and conclude the trial as early as possible preferably, within a period of six months from the date of framing of charge.
