Reply, which has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 in the Registry, is taken on record.

Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.334 dated 03.09.2014 registered under Sections 420/406 of IPC at Police Station Farkpur, District Yamuna Nagar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2).

On 02.03.2017, on the basis of the compromise, parties were directed to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements in support of the compromise.

As per the report dated 16.05.2017 submitted by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Yamunanagar, the complainant did not appear before the trial Court for recording his statement.

In the light of the fact that the complainant had not appeared before the trial Court for recording his statement, it appears that the compromise, which is alleged to have been entered into between the parties,

copy whereof has been placed on record as Annexure P-2, is not a genuine one.

In view of the above, since none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
