This petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C. for directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to arrest respondents No.4 to 7 and to proceed further in FIR No. 212 dated 04.10.2013, under sections 323/324/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri.

Notice of motion was issued by this Court and the State was directed to file status report regarding the investigation.

Today, status report dated 28.07.2017 has been filed in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this report, the petitioner had furnished an affidavit dated 30.08.2014 wherein it was stated that she had compromised the matter with the accused. Accordingly, the cancellation report was filed but the petitioner objected to the same before the learned trial Court and thus, further investigation was

ordered.

Learned State counsel submits that further investigation has been done and final report under section 173 Cr.P.C. has been presented. Respondents No.4 and 5 have been challaned.

In this view of the matter, nothing further required to be done in this case. Thus, the petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
